1. **Security & Privacy:** the impact of new technologies on security and privacy for governments, businesses and individuals;
2. **Health & Social Care:** how technology impacts on health and social care now and in the future;

3. **Services & Goods:** the role of technology to facilitate access to, and provision of, services and goods; and,
4. **Participation & Space:** digital technologies and their impact on social inclusion, democracy and attachment to physical places.

Participants will have the opportunity to share their research with others through a variety of mediums. These include:

- **Presenting** your research (or brainstorm a research idea) during one of the breakout sessions (15-20 minutes);

- **Exhibiting** a research poster as part of the poster competition; and,

- Presenting a 3 minute '**pecha-kucha**' style presentation and entering the respective competition at the Comedy Research Open Mic.

Presenters do not pay the conference fee.
